

Classy Way Consignment Boutique Consignment Agreement

Classy Way Consignment Boutique and Consignor understand and agree to the following:

Consignment hours are Monday thru Friday 11 AM - 5 PM and Saturday 11 AM - 3 PM. No appointment is necessary.

Classy Way shall accept up to ten (10) items per consignment -limited to once every two weeks (shoes and accessories are included in the count). Items must be in style and in season. Clothing needs be in good condition, clean, pressed and on hangers - Classy Way will return Consignor's hangers on request.

Classy Way accepts what they believe customers will buy... customers' preferences must dictate selections. Classy Way will return "no thank you" items at time of consignment, when possible. However, in the event that is not feasible, Consignor agrees to retrieve unwanted items within 72 hours of notification, and understands they may be donated to a local charity of not picked up within the allotted time.

Classy Way will price items based on a number of factors, including (but not limited to) current supply and demand for like items.

Items will be displayed for 60 days. During that time, prices will be strategically reduced to facilitate sales. A typical schedule is as follows: -20% after 3 weeks; -40% after 6 weeks; -50% after 7 weeks. Please understand that this is only a guideline and not an absolute rule. Exceptions may be made as deemed necessary by Classy Way management.

Consignors receive 40% of the selling price (50% if \$75.00 or more). Cash payouts are available immediately - no need to wait until the end of the consignment period. Classy Way mails checks upon request. Consignors are afforded a 20% discount on any non-reduced items when using their Consignor funds in the shop.

Unsold items may be retrieved at the end of the consignment period with a 72 hour notice. Those items which are not picked up within 72 hours of the consignment end date or the scheduled pick-up date shall become property of Classy Way Consignment Boutique to dispose of at management's discretion - typically donated to a local charity. Donation receipts for tax purposes are available upon request.

Classy Way will do its best to safeguard consignment item(s), but cannot be held responsible for loss or damage.
